



What is a good answer?

Always fill in the answer in full sentences using simple and clear language (no bullet lists!).

While answering the questions, it is most important to find explicit cases, rather than general statements.

What is a bad answer?

Writing about the following subjects is forbidden:

Cost

Strategy

Productivity

Communication

What is a good answer?



Our IT is too expensive and our CRM is inefficient.

This answer is too generic. It shows issues, but gives no explicit case to improve. A good answer could be:

This answer is better because it gives exact time information and shows a process ranging from the customer to the related system. It reveals which information is needed and where it is stored.

Our CRM is inefficient because it takes the sales representative 15 minutes to transfer the customer feedback (concerning our products and service) manually into word files in the file-system.



**Try to think in processes, and make sure to keep the 5w-questions in mind and relate the answers to the process.


Each answer that has been corrected by the professor is penalized.

For both, questionnaire and configuration filling, you get the possibility to improve the answers and configuration based on the comments made by the tutor. Although you get two marks (one after the first submission and one after your correction of the results) only the second mark is relevant for your final grading. As a result, it is possible to reach the maximum number of points if the correction of the configuration is done properly.

Why should you read?



The interview is a bilateral process between the interviewer and the company. A questionnaire is used to extract information about the company in a way which allows for the ERP configuration to be filled. The results of the interview will be transferred on-line. This visual guide will show you how what constitutes a good answer, and discuss the questions detailed.

Questionnaire Objectives

-  1. Analyzing what the company's strong point is.
→ For finding out what is not to be changed.
-  2. Analyzing what the company's weak point is.
→ For finding out what ERP5 could possibly improve.
-  3. Finding a possible solution proposal.
-  4. Getting informations about the facets of the company.
→ Sites, Roles, Functions, Products, Regions, ...
-  5. Ensure a high quality in the answers.

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The objectives of the questionnaire are listed above.

The starting point is to analyse what the company's strong point is. This is necessary to prevent changes in this field. Additionally, asking about positive processes first results in a more open communication culture in the interview.

Secondly, the weak point has to be analysed. This could be a process which is inefficient, redundant or oversized. It is most important to provide an explicit description of the process with all relevant key questions.

Thirdly, ERP5 is used to improve the weak point of the organization. The goal is finding and describing a possible future application area where ERP5 can be introduced.

The next step is to provide the information about the facets of the company to enable the configuration sheets to be filled in.

Finally, all questions have to be checked for their answer quality, explicitness and completeness.

While answering the questions, it is most important to find explicit cases, rather than general statements.

In order to provide high quality answers, the term “high quality answer” has to be defined in the context of the questionnaire. 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The first answer example shown is too generic. It shows issues (cost, inefficiency), but it gives no explicit case to improve. To make the answer more explicit, asking the 5-w questions (Who? What? Where? When? Why? How?) can analysing the relevant facets of the described process. Still the aim is to get a cohesive description of the process.

This question aims on identifying output of the company, encompassing products, services or trading goods. Give the highest possible detail on what is sold (with hierarchy), where it is sold and to whom it is sold.

It is also possible to use ERP5 only for a department or special task in the organisation. In this case both the company's (generally) and the department's (detailed) products have to be documented.

Provide details about all the contacts the company has. Both, suppliers and customers have contact persons your company communicates with. The goal is to get informations about the categories role, region, group and function so analyse the contacts regarding these categories.

Analyse the company's contacts on the customer and supplier side. Your company may have other contact roles, so think of possible classifications (size, location,...?). It is possible that contacts are organized in hierarchies (like in large companies with many subsidiaries).



Make sure to list key and unique skills that are specific for the company you're analysing.
